

# Edge Browser Extension - Management

Currently this is limited to IT Users via IT testing group within Intune.

Found under Device > Configuration there is a policy called Testing - Microsoft Edge Browser Extension Control.

This contains a wildcard blacklist of extensions with a whitelist of specific extension ids. This currently includes

1Password

UBlock Origin Lite

Grammarly; and

Scribe (Documentation creator)
