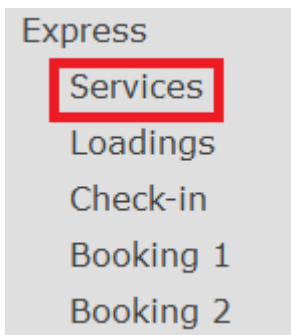


Adding a Stop Sell to an Express Service

The purpose of this procedure is to detail the steps for adding a stop sell to an express service in CustomLinc. Adding a stop sell to an express service will also apply a stop sell to any of the associated sightseeing products if all associated services are stop sold.

Stop Sell can be used to disable bookings for services e.g. on a a Total Fire Ban (TFB) day

1. From within CustomLinc click **Services** under the **Express** menu on the left of the screen



2. From the list of displayed express services, right click the required day and select **Stop Sell / Max Pax ...**
