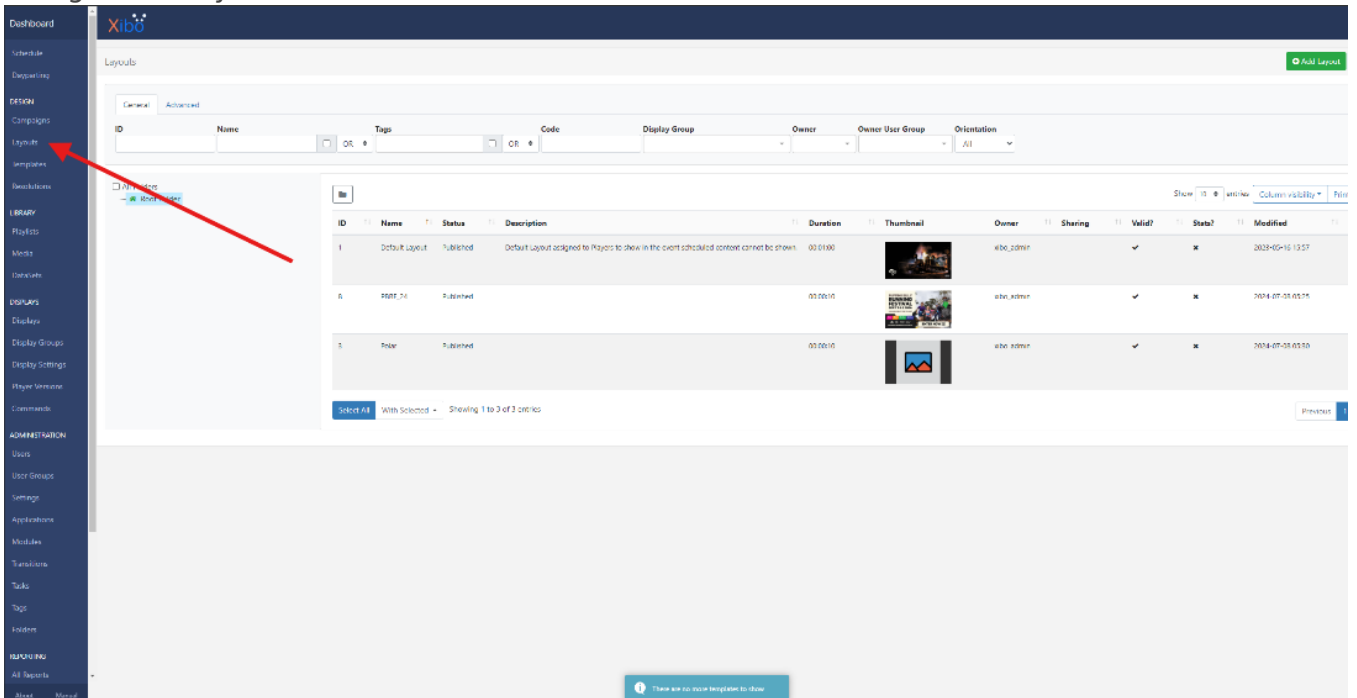


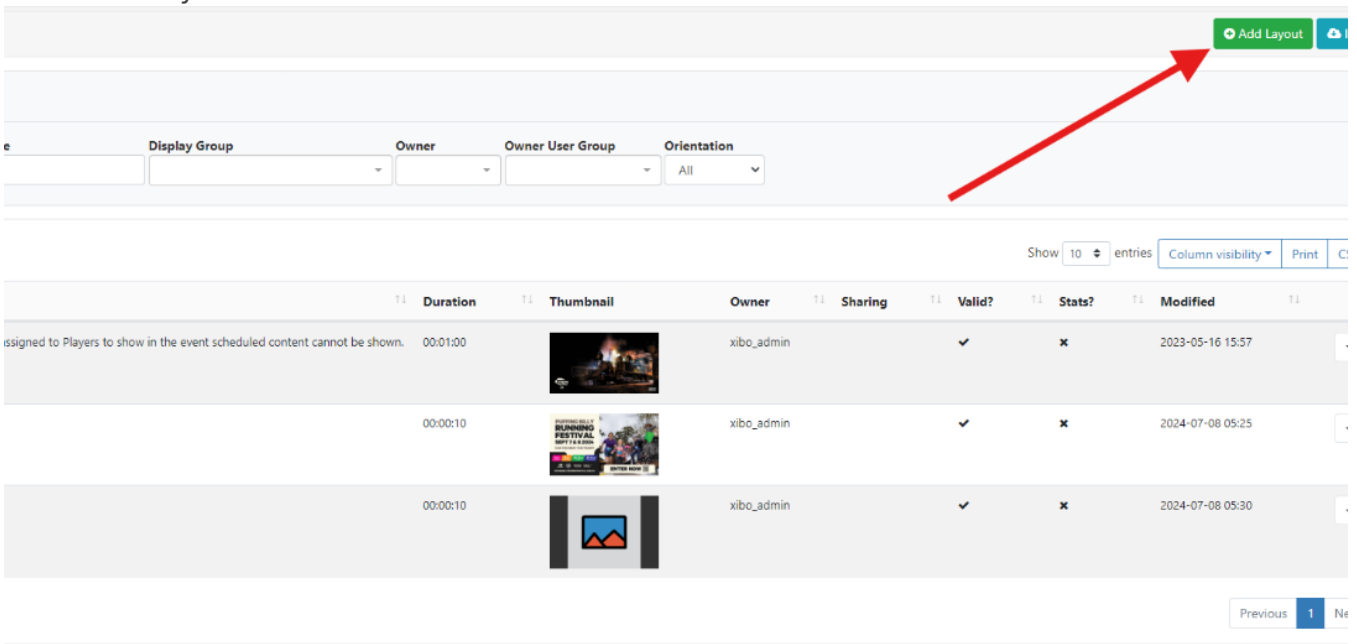
# Create a New Layout

1. Navigate to "layouts" on the left hand side menu.



2. Click "add layout".




3. Choose "full screen".



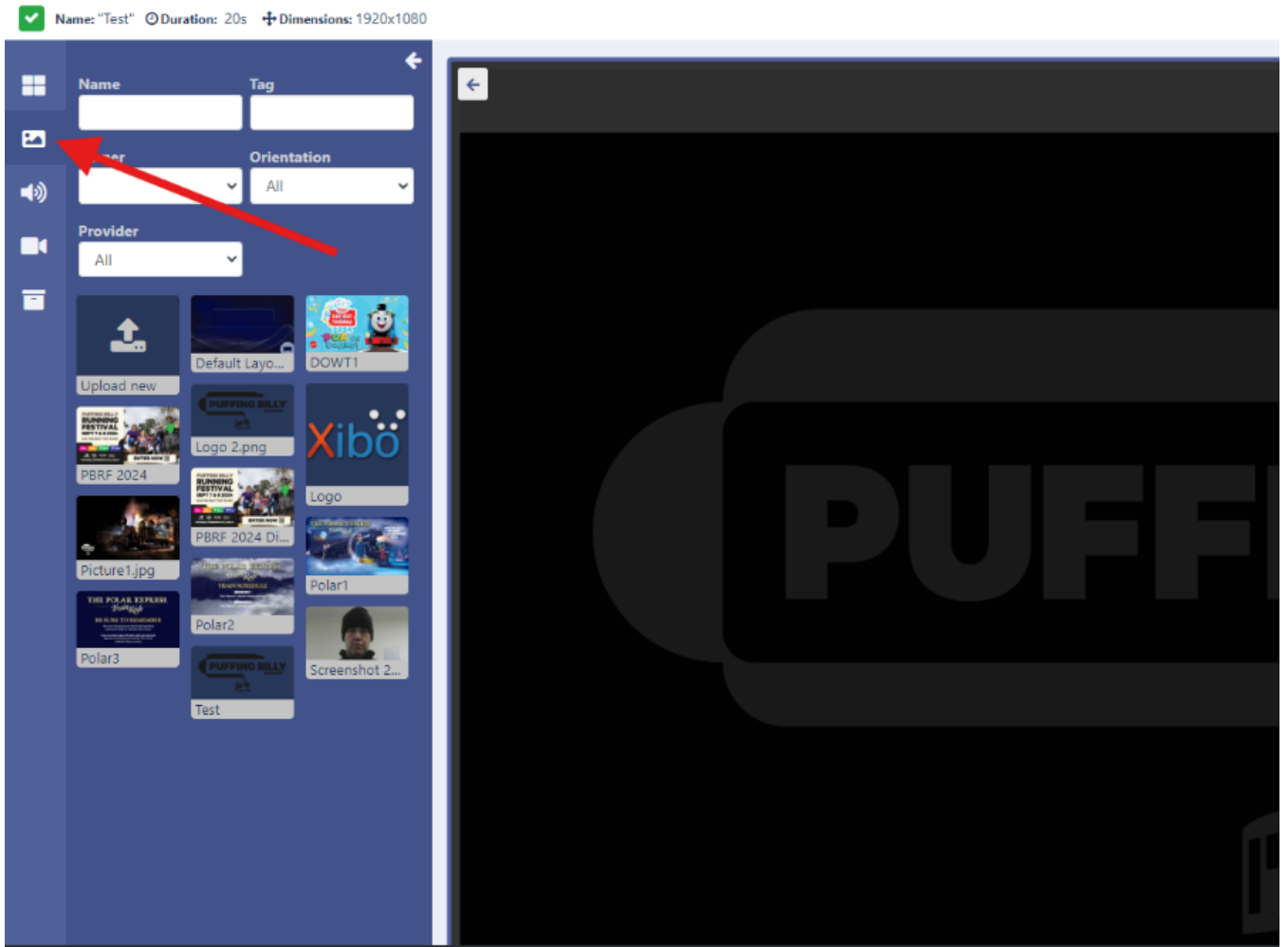
